2013	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Abdel Fattah el-Sisi reopens Egypt's embassy in Cairo, after Mohammed Morsi had closed it a month earlier.
2016	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ali Mamlouk, security advisor to Bashar al-Assad, undertakes an unofficial visit to Egypt.
2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The United Arab Emirates and Bahrain re-open their embassies in Damascus. Jordanian and Syrian officials meet for technical discussions regarding cross-border trade. Sudanese President Omar al-Bashir visits Syria. Ali Mamlouk meets with the Abbas Kamel, Head of Egypt's General Intelligence Service.
2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jordan appoints a chargé d'affaires to Damascus, though its embassy was never formally closed.
2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oman sends official ambassador to Syria.
March 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Syrian Foreign Minister Faisal al-Mekdad visits his Omani counterpart in Muscat.
April 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Iraqi Minister of Oil Ihsan Abdul Jabbar meets with his Syrian counterpart, Bassam Touma.
May 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Saudi Arabia reopens embassy in Damascus after meeting involving Bashar al-Assad, Ali Mamlouk, and Saudi intelligence Chief General Khalid al-Humaidan in Damascus. Syrian Tourism Minister Mohammed Rami Martini attends tourism conference in Riyadh.
June 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nassib-Jaber border crossing between Syria and Jordan reopens.
August 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Syria agrees to transfer Egyptian and Jordanian gas through its territory into Lebanon. Deal involves partial waiver of U.S. Caesar Sanctions for Lebanon and Jordan.
September 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lebanese delegation visits Damascus in official capacity. Syrian Defense Minister Ali Ayoub meets his Jordanian counterpart in Amman. Faisal al-Mekdad holds talks with the foreign ministers of Tunisia, Jordan, and Egypt on the sidelines of the 76th United Nations General Assembly in New York City.
October 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> King Abdullah II of Jordan takes official call from Bashar al-Assad, in first such call since 2012. Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Zayed al-Nahyan receives official call from Bashar al-Assad.
November 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> UAE Foreign Minister Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed al-Nahyan visits Bashar al-Assad in Damascus. Khalid al-Humaidan meets with Ali Mamlouk in Cairo.
March 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 37th Arab League Summit to take place in Algiers.
